Contending For The Faith Once For All Delivered To The Saints (Jude 3)
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"... AND THEIR CHILDREN DANCE" (Job 21:7-15)

We are to live "in the world" but yet be not "of the world" (Jn. 17:14f) when we obeyed the gospel of Christ the old manner of life was left behind (I Cor. 6:9-10; I Pet. 4:3). After baptism we became "new creatures!" (Rom. 6:4). As such we are to put on the fruits of righteousness Col. 3:1-4. We then are neither to love the world nor the things of the world. (I Jn. 2:15-17) Truly it must be said of us as was said of God's servants in the Old Testament: "be ye clean that bare the vessels of the Lord." (Isa. 52:11)

who practice such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. Gal. 5:19f Are you aware of the meaning of these words?

A. "Lasciviousness"--"indecent bodily movements, unchaste handling of males and females" (Thayer, p. 79,80) Webster says:

"lewd, wanton, lustful, tending to produce lude emotions"

B. "Revelling"--"feast and drinking parties that are protracted till late at night and indulge in revelry" (Thayer, p. 367) Note: Some Greek dictionaries include "dancing" here.

II. It's Fruits And Evil: Jesus taught one could judge a tree by its fruits (natt. 12:33). Evil companions, obscene languages, smoking, drinking, petting, adultry, drugs and divorce are present at the dance halls. Unless the fruits are good. the dance is evil:

The unfaithful disgraceful lives of dancing church members constitute an adequate answer to these questions. You will observe that dancers are not the ones that establish churches, teach the gospel, attend worship regularly and put the Son of God first in their lives but are usually the ones sitting on the back pews chewing gum, talking, and bored stiff at the prospect of going to heaven.

- Iv. Dancing Is "Of The World": Since it is revelry, lascivous, with fruits inevitably evil, and destroys spirituality, it should be obvious that it is not from above. (Jas. 1:27) In reading I Jn. 2:15-17 we can easily find all three condemnations applicable to the modern dance.
- V. Dancing Destroys The Christian's Influence: We are said to be the light of the world and the salt of the earth. By our life we can cause people to obey the gospel, and glorify God. (Matt. 5:16, I Pet. 3:1,2) We should not permit this power to grow dim by an evil or questionable practice! Certainly dancing lowers the estimation of the non-Christian to any "Christian" who engages in it. No one has ever been led to the spotless Son of God by a dancing child of His!

Perhaps we sometimes loose sight of just what draws people to obey the gospel. Carnelity can never bring out spirituality in an individual. You girls who dress to attract the fleshly eye of man will never win his spitit for heaven. (Rom. 8:5-9) If he won't be attracted by your godly life you had better forget him or loose your own soul!

3. "It is necessary for social popularity." -- This is probably the best defence made as few are so brazen

as to admit they like to dance because it gives them a chance to fondle females and to seduce them. Somehow I still think the people worth impressing look more favorably upon the pure and godly young man or woman than the boy or girl who "has made the rounds".

Many gloating parents push their sons or daughters into the dance to try to ensure their social acceptance and this lights the passion to continue. When the fruits of a wasted and mis-spent life in all its ugliness and horror appear, the parents pitifully wail, "I just can't understand how this has happened in our family." Maybe they should have read the context at the beginning of this paper again...it describles the wicked!
