## WHY SHOULD I BE BAPTIZED?

Just suppose that I should ask you the question, "Why should I be baptized?" What would you tell me? Would you tell me that I ought to be baptized in order to "join the church"? Or in order to show the world that I had been saved? Or as "an outward sign of an inward grace"? But suppose I should tell you that I cannot find those reasons in the Bible, and would you please give me some Scripture which tells me why I ought to be baptized. If you are the kind of person I hope you are, you would go get your Bible and begin looking up all the passages which deal with baptism and see whether any of those passages give a reason why one ought to be baptized. Of course, since Paul tells us that there is now only one baptism (Eph. 4:5) you would eliminate all baptisms except the one which Jesus commissioned his apostles and other disciples to teach and practice. When you had done this, you would find that this one baptism is mentioned about 35 times in the Bible and if you wrote all these down, you would be able to give me at least 10 good, scriptural reasons why one ought to be baptized. You could say, "One needs to be baptized in order to:

1. Obey the commandments of Christ. (Matt. 28:19,20, Mk. 16:16, Acts 10:48) Only those that do them have right to the tree of life (Rev. 22:14).

- 2. Get into the name of Christ
  (Matt 28:19,20; Acts 19:5 RV)
  There is salvation in no other name (Acts 4:12)
- 3. Get into the body of Christ (I Cor. 12:13). He is the Savior of the body (The church) Eph. 5:23.
- 4. Get into the death of Christ (Rom. 6:3,4) Since He died for us, His death does us no good unless and until we get into it where His blood can cleanse us from sin.
- 5. Get into Christ (Gal. 3:27; Rom. 6:3,4) Salvation can be had only in Christ (II Tim. 2:10)
- 6. Become a child of God (Gal. 3:26,27). Only children of God can be saved (Rom. 8:16,17; I Pet. 4:16-18).
- 7. Be made free from sin (Rom. 6:17,18).
- 8. Have remission of one's past sins (Acts 2:38).
- 9. Have your sins washed away (Acts 22:16).
- 10. To be saved (Mk. 16:16; I Pet. 3:21).

Now wait a minute! Every one of these reasons makes it necessary to be baptized in order to be saved. Sure does, friend. If you thought otherwisw, you have been tragically misinformed. But then, you have the scriptures right there before you. You looked them up yourself...didn't you?
