wrongs? Shall he, forsooth, either keep watch-service for others more than for Christ, or shall he do it on the Lord's Day, when he does not even do it for Christ himself? And shall he keep guard before the temples which he has renounced?...Then how many other offenses there are in the performance of camp offices, which we must hold to be a transgression of God's law, you may see by a slight survey.....Of course, if faith comes later and finds one pre-occupied with military service, their case is different, as in the instance of those whom John used to receive for baptism, and the centurion whom Peter instructs; yet, at the same time, when a man becomes a believer and the faith has been sealed, there must be either an immediate abandonment of it, WHICH HAS BEEN THE COURSE OF MANY; or all sorts of quibbling will have to be resorted to in order to avoid offending God." Tertullian, De Corona, Chapter 11

In closing let me make it abundantly clear that we are not Communists nor Hippies. A Christian Cannot be a Communist, (nor even a Socialist) (Heb. 11:6,Acts 5:4; 21:8) Neither can we be hippies. (I Cor. 11:14; II Thess. 3:10) and when we take advantage of the C.O. classifications we are violating no law but simply are doing what the law allows.
